Obituary:

Cassandra Yvette Brown – Blasingame was born in Chicago Illinois on December 26th, 1966. She was the only child born to Yvonne and Walter Brown. She is preceded in death by her father Walter Brown and Uncles, Stephen, Rodney, and Maurice Cannon. Cassandra Yvette Brown – Blasingame attended Lowell – Longfellow Elementary School in Harvey Illinois, Thornridge High School in Dolton Illinois, and Eastern Illinois University in Charleston Illinois. Cassandra's passion in life was serving people. She worked 10 years for the Salvation Army as a floor coordinator and an additional 10 years working for various Catholic Charities shelter organizations such as, Bill Kelly House, The Exodus Hotel, and Higher Ground. Most recently, Cassandra spent 17 years working for ATS&R, an architectural firm in Golden Valley, MN. Cassandra leaves behind to cherish her memories, her mother Yvonne Brown of Glenwood Illinois. Two daughters Tanisha La'Shaun BrownBlasingame, and Roshandra Michelle Brown-Blasingame of Brooklyn Park, MN. And brother Iris Brown of Frisco Texas along with a host of other family and friends. Cassandra was extremely passionate and a dedicated supporter of building up people, especially women and children. She always made it her business to uplift everyone she met, even through her illnesses. Many would say she missed her calling as a comedian as she loved to make people laugh. She was always quick witted and cracking jokes. In the 90's she started the All-American Girls dance group which went on to be one of the first all-black dance teams to grace many of the parades in the Twin Cities area. As a part of her church she made sure all children had baskets on Easter Sunday and that friends and family day had plenty of food. She loved to host events with family and deemed herself the party planner. She wanted to make anyone's special day a memorable one. Her legacy will be her two daughters who she loved dearly and very giving nature.

Cassandra was not only my first cousin, she was my BFF. She is the only

person I could call morning, noon, or night; it didn't matter, she listened and gave great advice. Didn't have to worry about her telling my secrets or judging me. Very smart, intelligent, and to those that knew her; she was a natural comedian. You've earned your wings and your crown cousin. 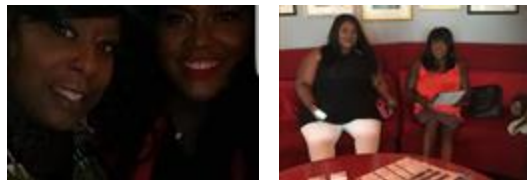

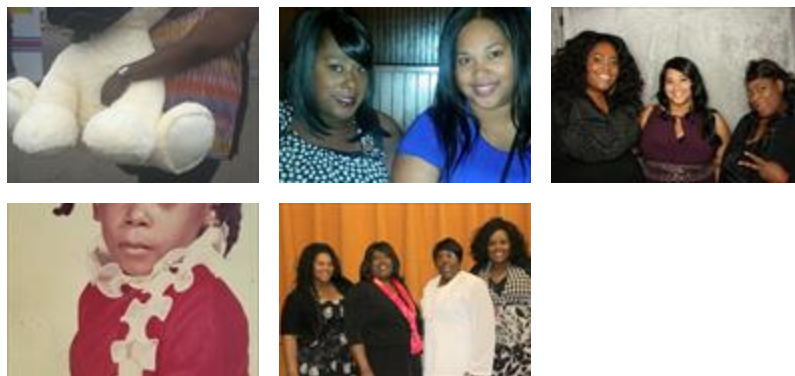
