Leon Adolphus Trawick passed away on May 6, 2022. He was a retired Minneapolis attorney with over 4 decades of experience in general and criminal law. He was a respected litigator and trial attorney who was recognized by peers and the legal community for his intelligence and legal acumen.

Leon was born and raised in Washington, DC, accepted a full scholarship to attend the U of Minnesota, participated as a starting member of the 1967 U of M Championship Gopher Football Team, was a proud member of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity - Epsilon Rho Chapter, and received a BA degree in Psychology. After receiving the Juris Doctorate in 1973 from the U of M Law School, Leon partnered with a former law school classmate to establish Trawick and Smith until his retirement in 2016.

Leon was outgoing, had a big smile, a big voice, and a tremendous sense of humor. He truly enjoyed connecting with people, especially when the conversation turned to politics, stocks, or sports. He was also a devoted son who moved his mother to his Minneapolis home where he cared for her until she passed in 2012.

Leon leaves to mourn, his sister LaVergne Trawick, PhD; his aunt Ellen Douglas; cousins Muriel Sherriff, Robert Hopson, Arnold (Sandra) Hopson; Paul Hopson; David (Debra) Hopson, Grady (Martha) Cornish, and a host of friends and colleagues.
